Complainant ERIN K. KUSUMOTO (Complainant or Kusumoto) filed a Motion for Leave to Amend, which Respondents HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) and DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, State of Hawai‘i (DOE, and, collectively with HGEA, Respondents) opposed.
