
**MINUTE ORDER**


1. Respondent DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, State of Hawai'i (DOE) to file a statement with the Board regarding whether DOE intends to present a case in response to Complainant ERIN K. KUSUMOTO's (Kusumoto or Complainant) case-in-chief against DOE, by **Tuesday, February 8, 2022 at 4:30 p.m.**;
2. DOE to file its Motion for Directed Verdict and any supporting memorandum by **Tuesday, March 22, 2022 at 4:30 p.m.**; and
3. Complainant and Respondent HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) to file any responses to the Motion for Directed Verdict by **April 4, 2022 at 4:30 p.m.**
