ORDER SETTING DEADLINE FOR PARTIES TO SUBMIT BRIEFS

The Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) received the Petition for Clarification or Amendment of Appropriate Bargaining Unit (Petition) in this case on July 29, 2019, and granted the Petition for Intervention filed by Intervenors DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, State of Hawai'i; and DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN RESOURCES DEVELOPMENT, State of Hawai'i (collectively, Intervenors) on August 20, 2019.

The Board held a Board Conference on this matter on August 29, 2019 and set a deadline of September 30, 2019 for briefs to be submitted. The parties agreed to stay this case on September 24, 2019, and the Board granted this request on September 30, 2019.

Intervenors submitted their Brief on the Petition on September 30, 2019.

The Board issued a Notice of Intent to Dismiss this case on May 24, 2021, which Petitioner HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) objected to on June 3, 2021.

In its Objection, HGEA asked for at least 90 days to conclude its follow up and submit a memorandum in support of its position.

More than 90 days have passed since June 3, 2021.

Accordingly, the Board orders that any and all briefs in this case be filed on or by November 5, 2021. Any briefs filed after this date will not be considered. The Board will not entertain any stipulations between the parties to alter this date. Any motions or other requests to extend this date must be submitted to the Board, showing good cause as to why an extension should be granted, given the foregoing.
