ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS

On February 22, 2022, Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO (HGEA) filed with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) a Stipulation to Stay Prohibited Practice Complaint (Stipulation) signed by Stacy Moniz, Representative for HGEA, and Richard H. Thomason, Deputy Attorney General, attorney for Respondents EXECUTIVE BRANCH, State of Hawai'i; DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, State of Hawai'i; and HAWAI'I STATE JUDICIARY, State of Hawai'i.

In the Stipulation, the parties state that they are engaged in settlement discussions and factfinding and have agreed to stay the instant case, including all relevant prehearing deadlines for at least sixty (60) days.

Based on the Stipulation, the Board orders that the proceedings in the instant case will be stayed until such time as the Board reschedules any deadlines or dates.
