ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR CHANGE TO SCHEDULE

Complainant PATRICK ISHIDA (Complainant) filed with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) a Prohibited Practice Complaint. The Board issued Order No. 3825; Pretrial Order and Notices setting hearing dates and deadlines.

After receiving Order No. 3825, Complainant filed a Motion for Change of (10) Schedule of Hearings, Conference, and Deadlines (Motion). Respondent UNITED PUBLIC WORKERS, AFSCME, LOCAL 646, AFL-CIO (UPW) submitted a statement of no opposition to the Motion and requested that a status conference be set.

Both parties have waived the requirements of Hawai'i Revised Statutes (HRS) § 377-9(b), which mandates a hearing on the merits within 40-days.

Accordingly, noting the parties' waiver of the requirements of HRS § 377-9(b) and Hawai'i Administrative Rules § 12-42-46(b), the Board grants the Motion. The Board will hold these proceedings in abeyance.
