ORDER STAYING PROCEEDINGS

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On April 5, 2022, Keani Alapa, Esq., attorney for Complainant HAWAII GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION, AFSCME, LOCAL 152, AFL-CIO, filed with the Hawai'i Labor Relation Board (Board) a Stipulation to Stay Proceedings Pending Continued Negotiations (Stipulation) signed by Mr. Alapa and Darin Leong, Esq., attorney for Respondent HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

In the Stipulation, the parties, among other things, agree to waive the requirements of Hawai'i Revised Statutes § 377-9(b) and Hawai'i Administrative Rules § 12-42-46(b) requiring a hearing within 40 days of filing of a prohibited practice complaint and stipulate to stay the proceedings in this case.

Based on the Stipulation, the Board orders that the proceedings in the instant case will be stayed until such time as the Board reschedules any deadlines or dates.
