ORDER CANCELLING BRIEFING SCHEDULE

Respondent DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, State of Hawai‘i (DOE) made an oral motion to disqualify counsel for Complainant ERIN K. KUSUMOTO (Kusumoto) at the hearing on the merits (HOM) held in this case on March 23, 2022. Based on the oral motion, the Hawai‘i Labor Relations Board (Board) issued Order No. 3832, which ordered the parties to submit written briefs regarding DOE’s oral motion on or by April 11, 2022.

On April 6, 2022, DOE filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Oral Motion, withdrawing its oral motion to disqualify Kusumoto’s counsel.

Accordingly, the deadline set in Order No. 3832 for briefs regarding the oral motion is cancelled. The Board will discuss future days for HOM with the parties and will issue a notice of those days.
