### **ORDER REGARDING DISPOSITIVE MOTIONS**

The Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) held a Status Conference in this case on April 21, 2022. At the Status Conference, the parties represented that they intend to file dispositive motions.

Accordingly, the Board orders:

1. All dispositive motions must be filed on or before **June 15, 2022** at 4:30 p.m.;
2. All responses to dispositive motions must be filed on or by **June 22, 2022** at 4:30 p.m.
3. Memoranda in support of or in opposition to any motion must not exceed 25 pages in length, exclusive of table of contents, table of authorities, declarations, exhibits, and other attachments;
4. Memoranda exceeding 10 pages must have a table of contents and a table of authorities; and
5. Exhibits to memoranda may not include statutes; Board Orders or Decisions; publicly accessible court cases, pleadings, or transcripts; arbitration decisions,

pleadings, or transcripts that are not specifically factually relevant (for example, where the Complainant alleges that an arbitration they participated in has an impact on the case); or prior filings in the instant case, including exhibits presented in prior filings. Statutes, Board Orders and Decisions, court cases, and prior filings may be referenced in memoranda appropriately.
