NOTICE OF INTENT TO DISMISS

Complainant NARCIS D. SALERA (Complainant or Salera) filed his prohibited practice complaint (Complaint) with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) on June 30, 2022. Upon review, it appears that the Complaint in this case is substantially similar to the proposed Third Amended Complaint in Board Case No. 20-CE-01-952, Salera v. Babcock (952).

On July 7, 2022, the Board issued an order granting the motion to amend the complaint in <u>952</u>. After review of the complaint in this case and the Third Amended Complaint ordered to be filed in <u>952</u>, the Board finds that this case should be dismissed based on Hawai'i Administrative Rules (HAR) § 12-42-42(f), which states that "Only one complaint shall issue against a party with respect to a single controversy."

Accordingly, the Board hereby provides the parties notice that the complaint will be dismissed unless a written objection is received from any party within ten days issuance of this notice, setting forth good cause as to why the case should not be dismissed.
