ORDER ACCEPTING, IN PART, THE STIPULATION TO STAY CASE

On December 12, 2022, the parties to this case filed with the Hawai'i Labor Relations Board (Board) a stipulation to stay this action and the filing of Answers by Respondents (Stipulation) until further written notice from any party to enable the parties to engage in settlement discussions and attempt to resolve this case.

While the Board accepts, in part, the Stipulation of the parties and acknowledges their efforts to engage in settlement discussions and attempts for resolution, the Board cannot ignore that the original prohibited practice complaint was filed over 13 years ago. The Board emphasizes to the parties that this case requires progress on a resolution whether by action of the parties through settlement or otherwise or by proceeding to a hearing on the merits.

Therefore, the Board orders that, with the exception of the Status Conference scheduled below, this case, including the filing of the Answers to the Second Amended Prohibited Practice Complaint, is stayed.
