INTEREST ARBITRATION AND MEDIATION FEE: Interest Arbitration and Mediation per diem: \$2,800.00 each (7-hour) day for interest arbitration or grievance mediation, research, study, and writing time, plus the <u>cost of travel from Hawaii Airport to Arbitration</u>, and overnight lodging. <u>No charge for meals</u>.

CANCELLATION FEES: Cancellation and set over fees: one day's fee per scheduled day of hearing if notice is received by my office less than 30 days prior to the scheduled beginning of the hearing. For hearings scheduled for 3-4 days, the minimum cancellation/set over notice period is 60 days; for 5 plus day hearings it is 90 days.
