ORDER #4 (Modification to Filing Procedure)

On March 17, 2020, the Labor and Industrial Relations Appeals Board issued Order #1, which provided for alternate means of filing documents with the Board. It also stated that the Board would only allow e-mailed filings if the Board’s office were to close.

This Order modifies Order #1 to permit filings via the following methods during the disaster emergency relief period:

1. By First class mail; or
2. By facsimile to (808) 586-8599; or
3. By email, preferably secure/encrypted, to dlir.appealsboard@hawaii.gov.
