ORDER #6
RELATING TO LIRAB PROCEEDINGS IN RESPONSE TO THE
COVID-19 PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

On May 28, 2020, the Labor and Industrial Relations Appeals Board issued Order #5 Relating to LIRAB Proceedings in Response to the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency.

Among the orders therein, all conferences, motion hearings, and trials scheduled through July 31, 2020, were ordered to be rescheduled, unless otherwise informed by LIRAB.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that unless parties are informed otherwise by LIRAB, all conferences, motion hearings, and trials scheduled through August 31, 2020, will be rescheduled.

In moving toward the resumption to full operations, LIRAB will be scheduling and noticing remote status conferences to discuss further proceedings in most cases. Parties should expect that all presently scheduled conferences, motion hearings, and trials presently on calendar may be subject to rescheduling.

The remainder of Order #5 remains in effect. This Order #6 is subject to further amendment.
