2018 State of Hawaii Income Eligibility Guidelines**

For an individual or household to be eligible for TEFAP commodities in the State of Hawaii, they must have a total gross income no greater than 185% of the amount specified in the U.S. Federal Poverty Guidelines for the State of Hawaii. To determine your eligibility for the USDA/TEFAP Commodities, your household income must be at or below the annual household income listed below based on your family size:

For family units of more than 8 members, add \$9,195.00 for each additional person for annual household income.

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
