- You only need to file for weeks that you did not work or worked less than full time hours, had gross earnings that are less than your weekly benefit amount and accepted all work offered by your employer. (Example: If your unemployment weekly benefit is \$559.00 and you worked less than full-time hours, had gross earnings of \$400.00 and accepted all work offered by your employer, a claim for benefits should be filed.)

6. In addition, partial claimants must have their employer(s) file "Weekly Report of Low Earnings" online for each week claimed. Advise your employer to go to: <http://uiclaims.hawaii.gov> and register. Be sure to notify your employer of the week or weeks you claimed.

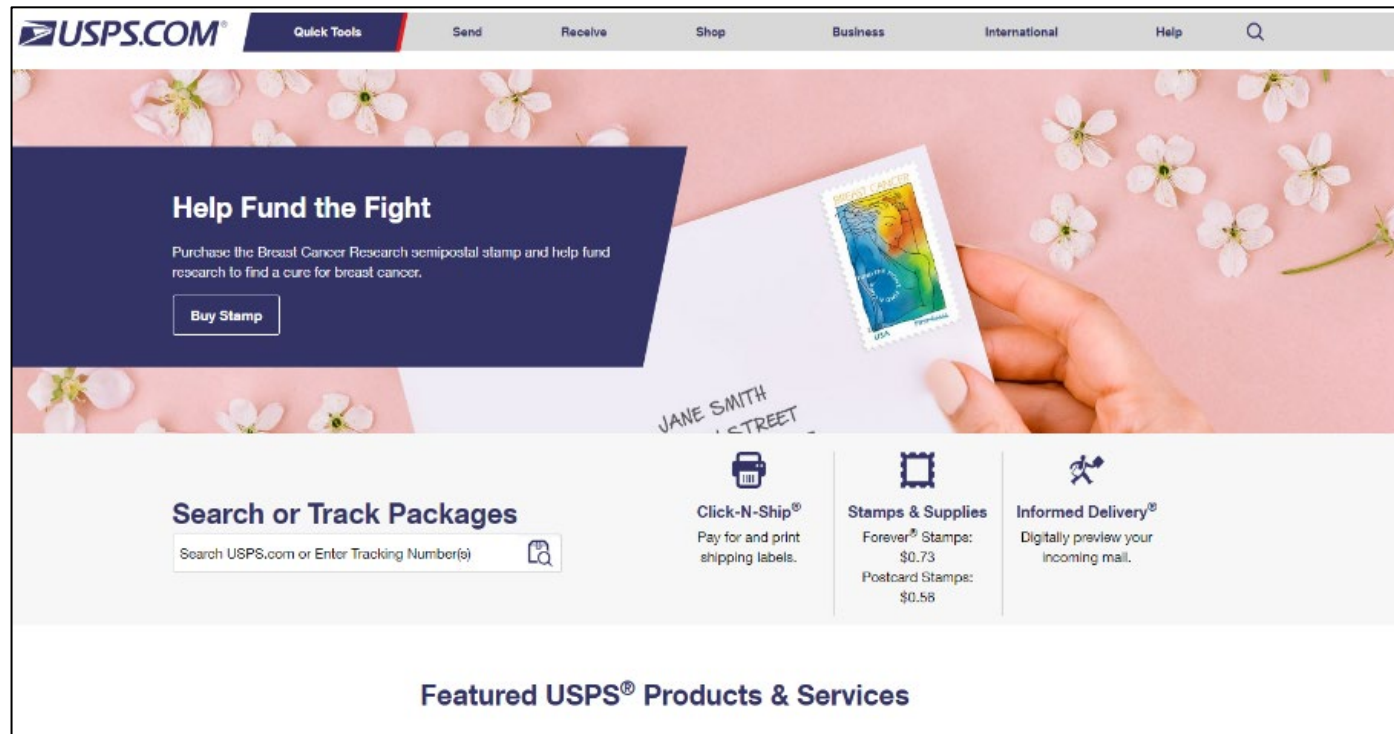
