I. Proposed Performance Goals for PY 14

The State's proposed performance goals for PY 14 WIA and Wagner-Peyser programs are the following:

WIA Adults

II. Methodology

The goals were primarily based on the past performance, regression targets, and continuous improvement objective. There were no major changes in the service delivery mix or economic conditions from the prior year. Although increased emphasis will be placed on assisting special populations such as veterans, recently released inmates, long-term unemployed, and foster care youth during PY 14, the effect of their enrollment is unlikely to have a significant effect on performance until PY 15 and later.

All goals show improvement over the last three quarters of PY 13 to encourage continuous improvement, optimize customer satisfaction, and increase return on investment. The one exception is the goal for WIA Dislocated Worker Average Earnings, which is set at the same level as the regression model target. Performance for this measure has been fairly consistent from PY 12 through the first three quarters of PY 13 except for a spike in the second quarter which appears to be an anomaly. The regression model is therefore a more accurate predictor of performance.

The worksheet on the following pages shows performance from PY 08 to the third quarter of PY 13, GPRA goals, regression model targets, and the State's proposed goals. Unemployment rates of the State and the nation are also displayed. These data were considered in the development of goals for PY 14.

III. Public Review and Comment

The State's proposed performance goals and supporting worksheet will be posted on the State Workforce Development Council's website for public review and comment on May 22, 2014 until June 4, 2014. The information also will be provided to the Local WIB Chairs and Counties, discussed during a Workforce Development Council Planning and Performance Committee meeting on May 27, 2014, and made available to the full Workforce Development Council membership for comments.

IV. Inclusion in State Plan

When the goals are negotiated and agreed to by USDOL and the State, the State assures that the goals will be included in the State's official copy of the State Plan and posted on the Workforce Development Council website with the State Plan.
