

<p>(a) ESTABLISHMENT.--There shall be established in each local area of a State, and certified by the Governor of the State, a local workforce investment board, to set policy for the portion of the statewide workforce investment system within investment system").</p> <p>(b) MEMBERSHIP.—</p> <p>(1) STATE CRITERIA.--The Governor of the State, in partnership with the State board, shall establish criteria for use by chief elected officials in the local areas for appointment of members of the local boards in such local areas in accordance with the requirements of paragraph (2).</p> <p>(3) AUTHORITY OF BOARD MEMBERS.--Members of the board that represent organizations, agencies, or other entities shall be individuals with optimum policymaking authority within the organizations, agencies, or entities.</p>
