You have the opportunity to participate in the state's **only** teacher externship program this year. Have you wondered how industry needs are changing, what are the latest workforce trends, job skills, and competencies needed in today's workplace? This summer, you will have the opportunity to get first hand knowledge, on-the-job experience and network with some of Hawaii's top business leaders. This externship experience will help better prepare your students for the realities and needs of Hawaii's workforce. Teachers will be placed into a business over the summer based on your CTE teaching areas.

## APPLY NOW!

- Who:** Open to any CTE secondary teacher (grades 9-12) statewide (across all pathways).  
**Note:** *A total of 25 teachers will be selected to participate.*
- When:** Application period open from now until April 3, 2018. Note: You will be notified by mid-April if you are selected.

- Earn:** A stipend of \$1,500 will be provided to each teacher selected. Participants will also receive a free Platinum Nepris license.

## IF SELECTED, TIME COMMITMENT

- **May 1 or 2** Attend one mandatory "Orientation" meeting. (Note: May 1 from 3:45-5:15 p.m. at OCISS office or May 2 from 3:45-5:15 p.m. location TBD). Neighbor island teachers can attend via Zoom or other online webinar platform.
- **June to Aug** Teacher extern will work at a business host site during the summer. A minimum of 40 hours is required.
- **July** Participate in a conference call so teacher externs can exchange ideas with peers.
- **Sept** Teacher extern will network with other "non-extern" CTE teachers to share experiences, classroom applications, and student learning.
- **Sept-Nov** Teacher extern will teach at least three lessons (focused on industry and course standards) for their CTE students and will collect evidence of student learning during the fall. A description of the lessons and the assessments will be emailed to HIDEOE. Video and images are preferred.  
  
Teacher externs will utilize Nepris at least three times in the classroom (e.g., student performance based assessments, industry chats, etc.).
- **Feb. 2019** Teacher externs will share their experiences at the Hawaii Association of Career and Technical Education Conference. (Date, time, location TBD).
