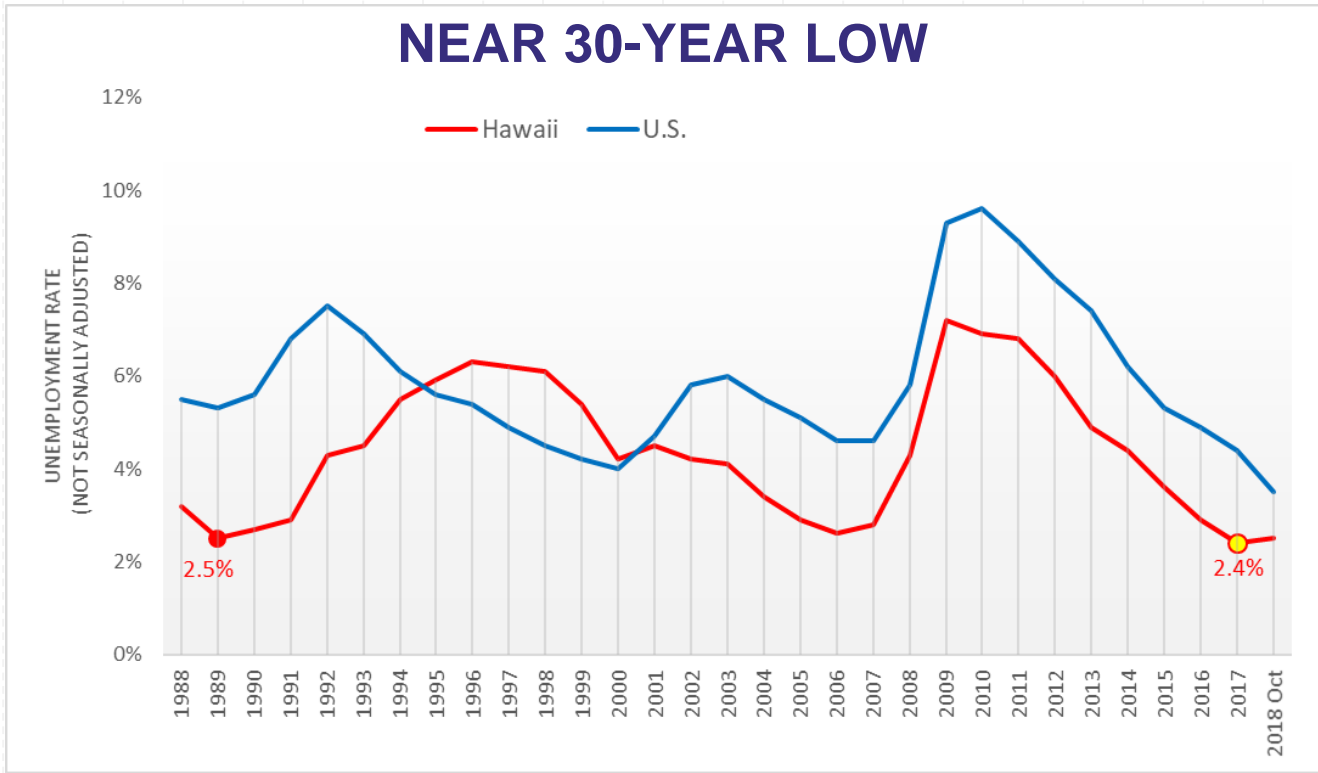

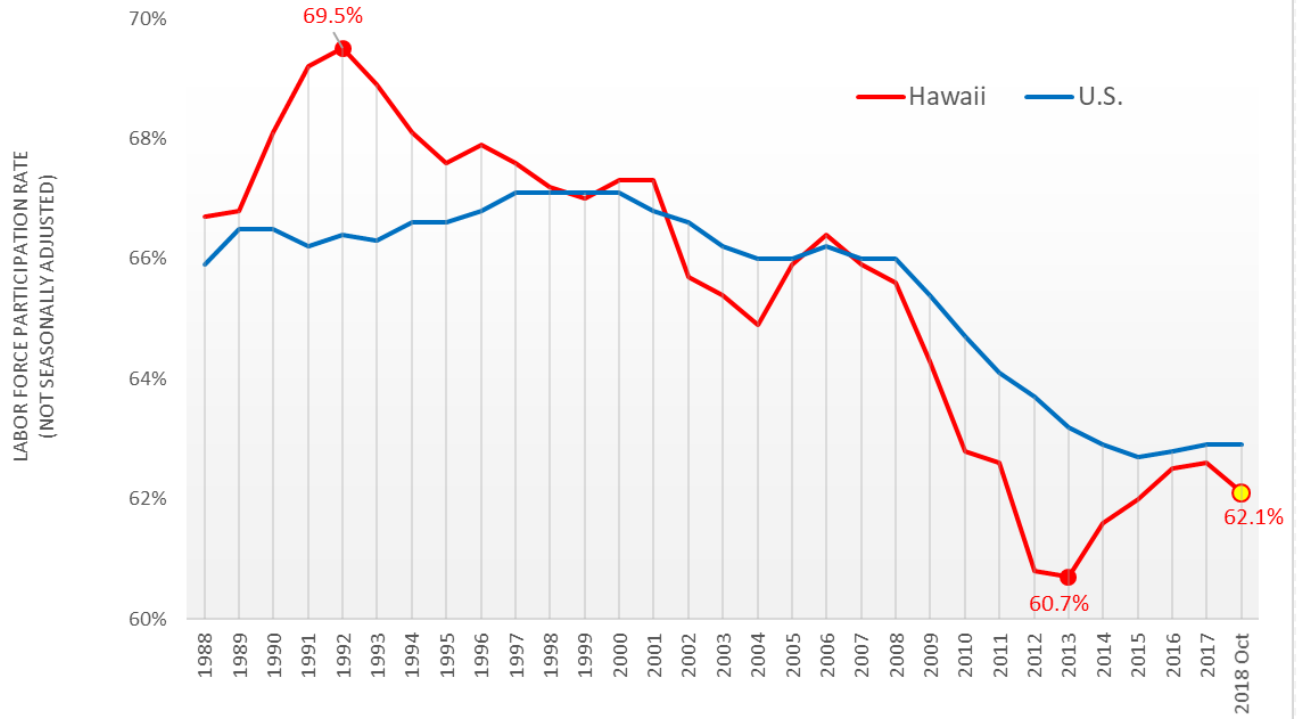

ICYMI . . . HAWAII'S UNEMPLOYMENT RATE NEAR 30-YEAR LOW

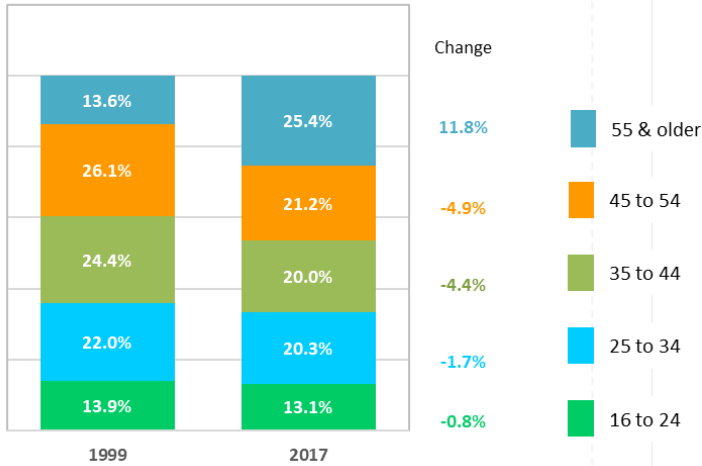


LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION RATE IMPROVING

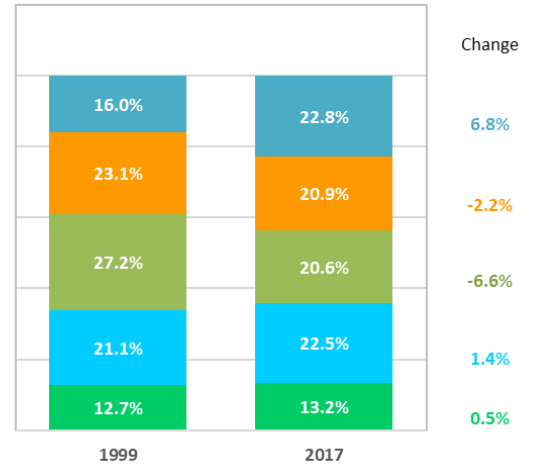


CIVILIAN LABOR FORCE GROWS OLDER

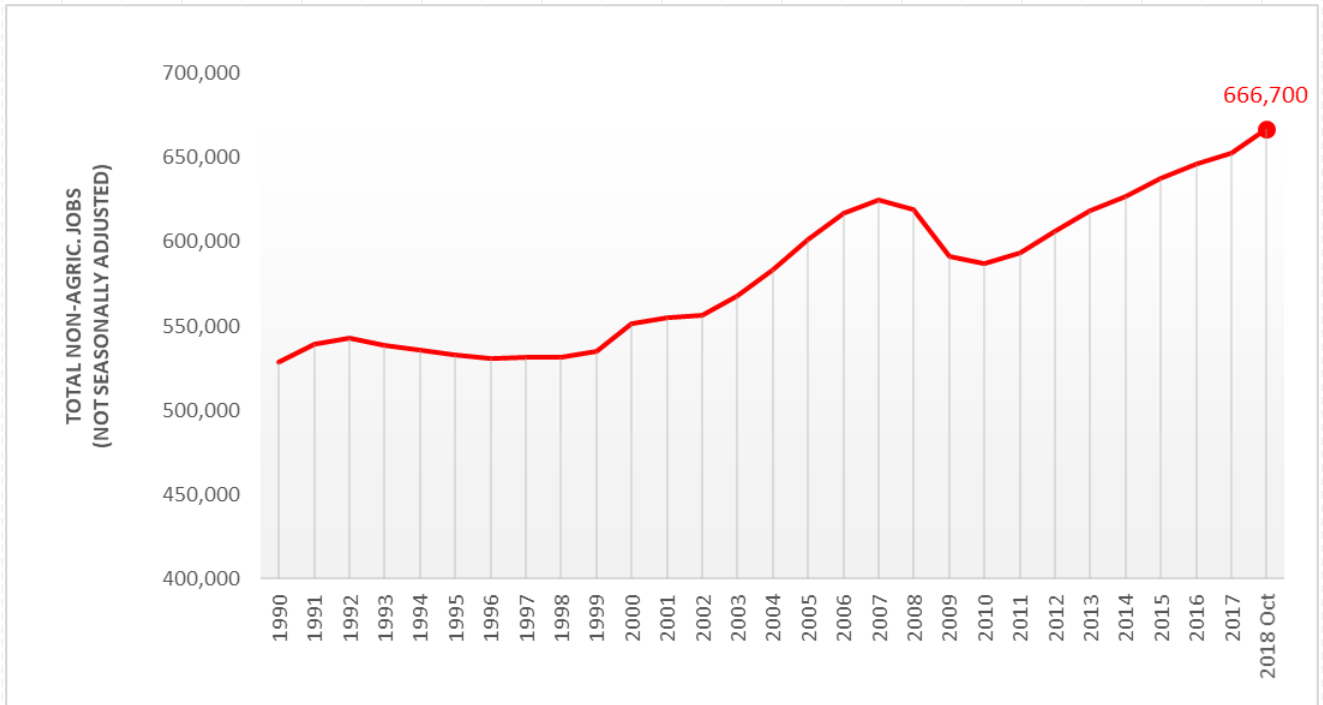

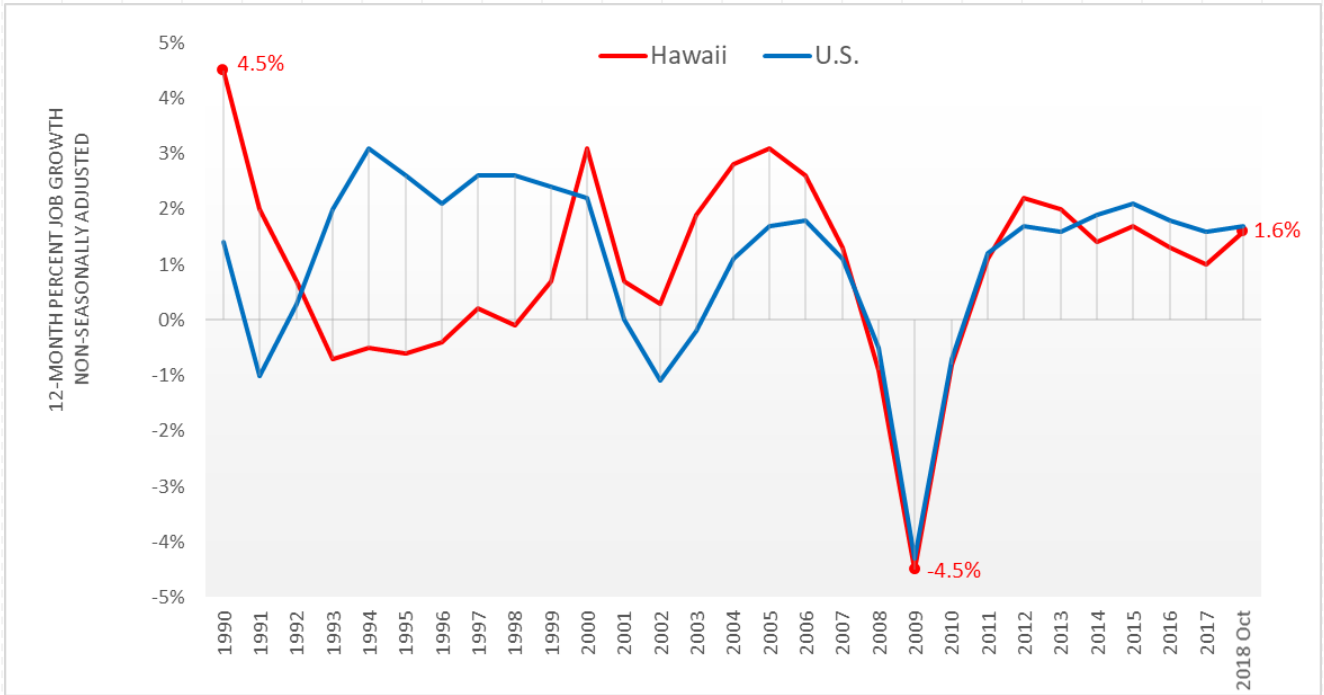

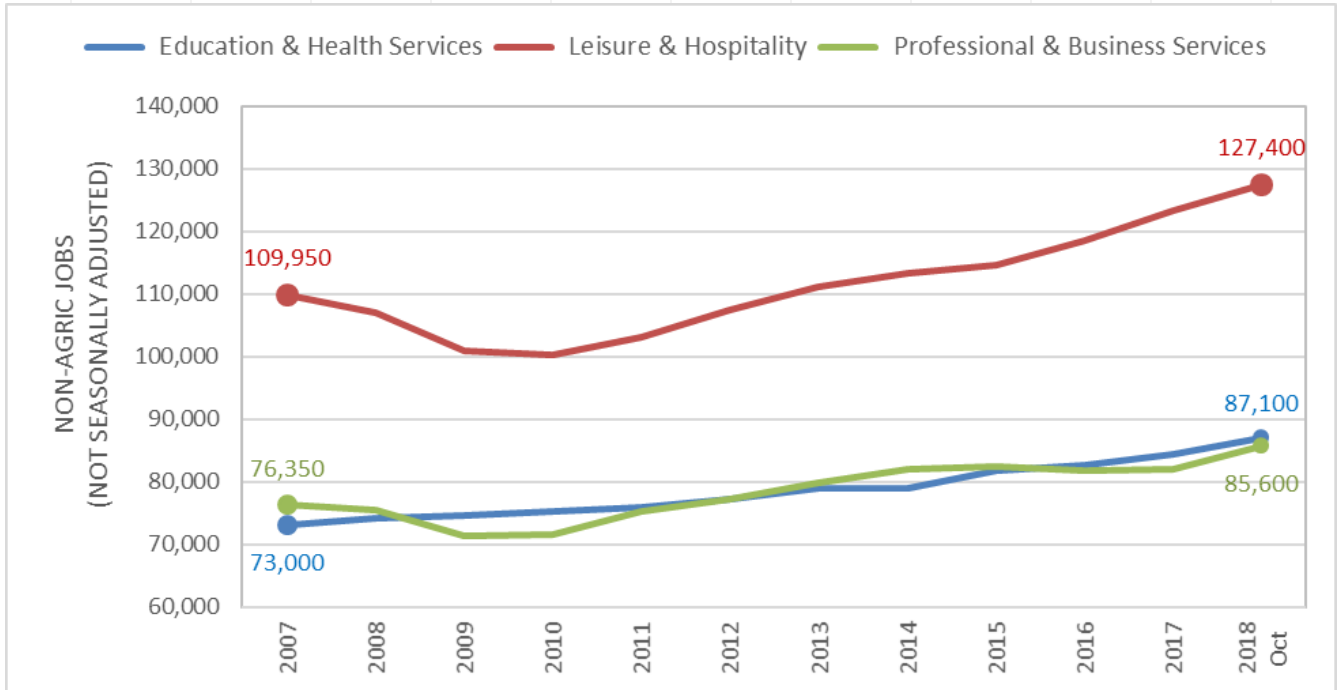
HAWAI‘I’S JOB COUNT CONTINUES TO GROW



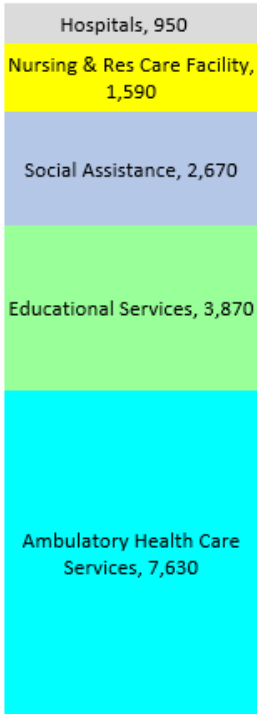
HAWAII'S JOB GROWTH SLOWER THAN NATION



10-YEAR GROWTH OF TOP INDUSTRIES



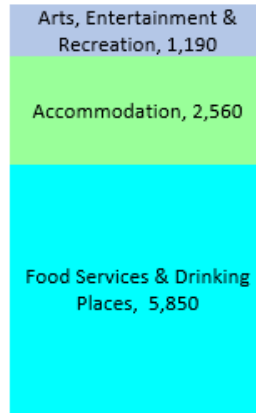

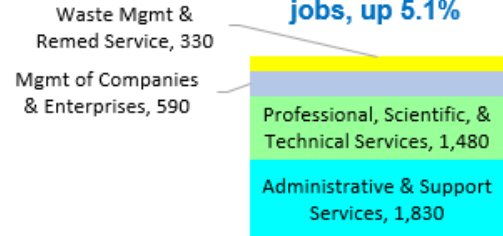
THE OUTLOOK OF HAWAII'S TOP THREE INDUSTRIES TO 2026

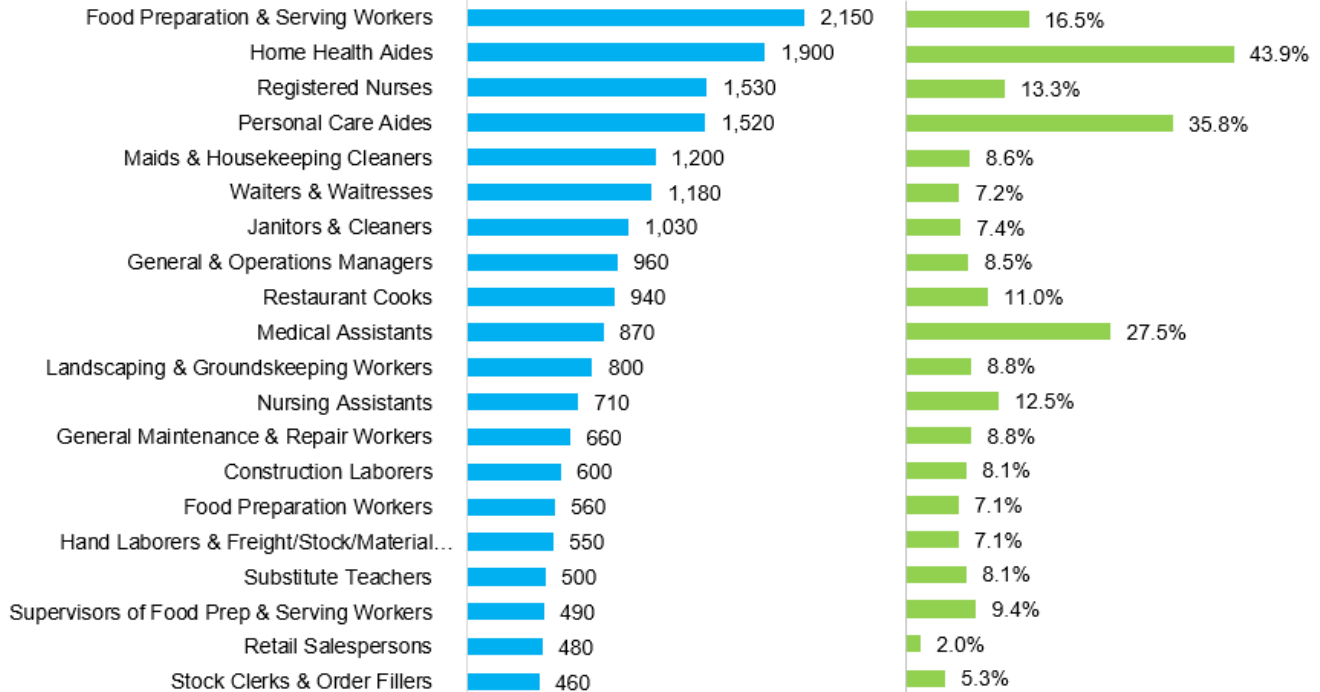

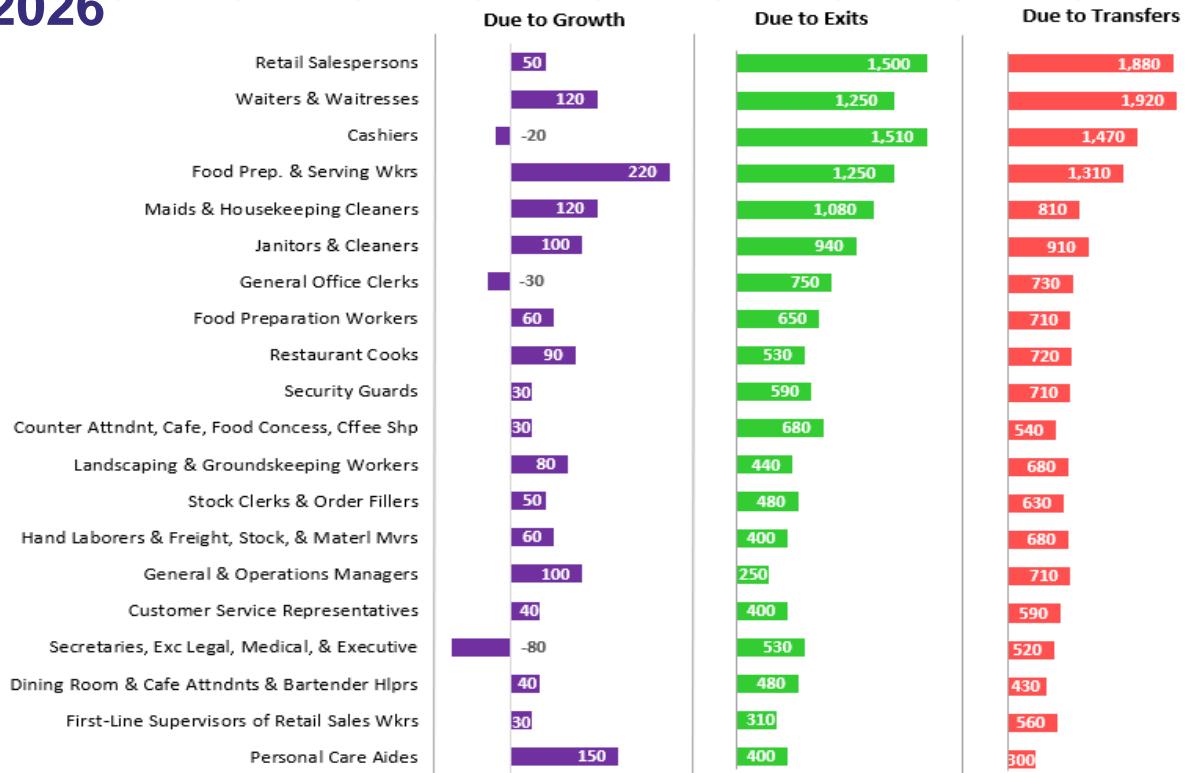
JOBS WITH BEST GROWTH POTENTIAL FROM NOW TO 2026

Percent Growth

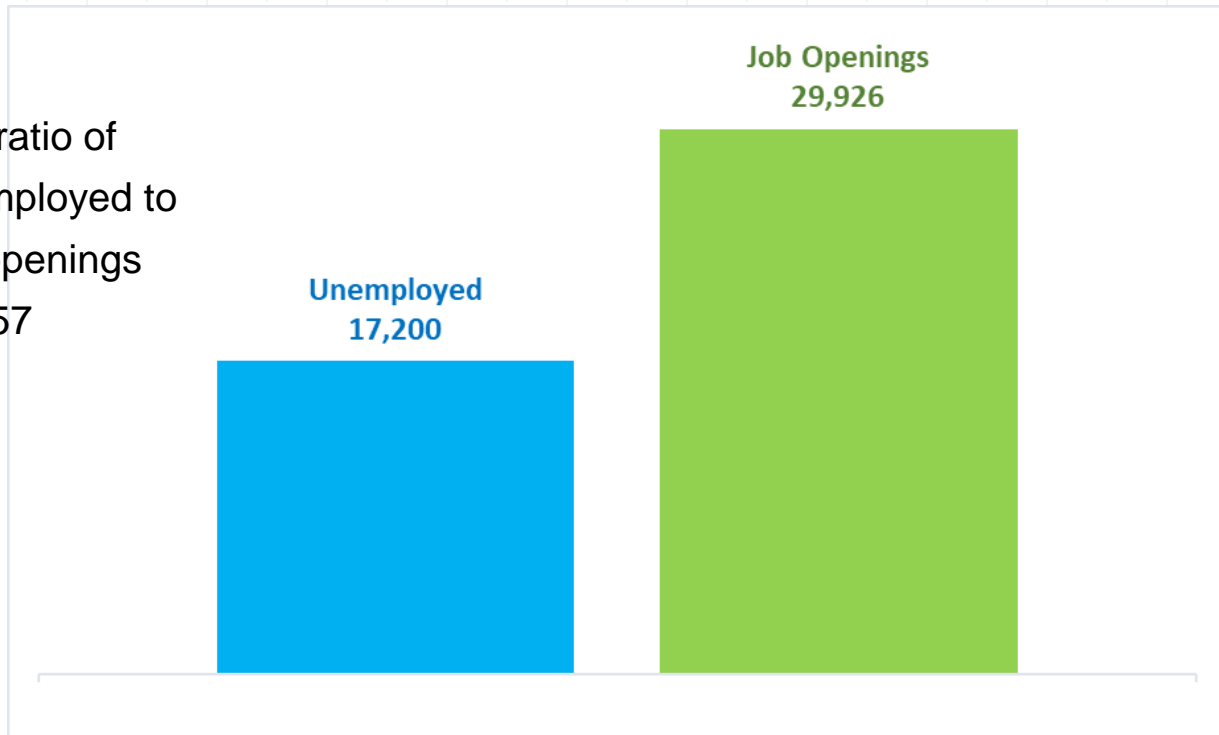


JOBS WITH THE MOST OPENINGS FROM NOW TO 2026



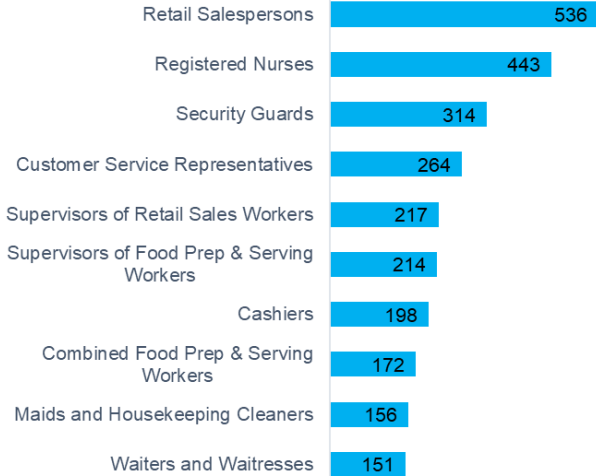
MORE JOB OPENINGS THAN PEOPLE LOOKING FOR WORK

The ratio of unemployed to job openings is 0.57

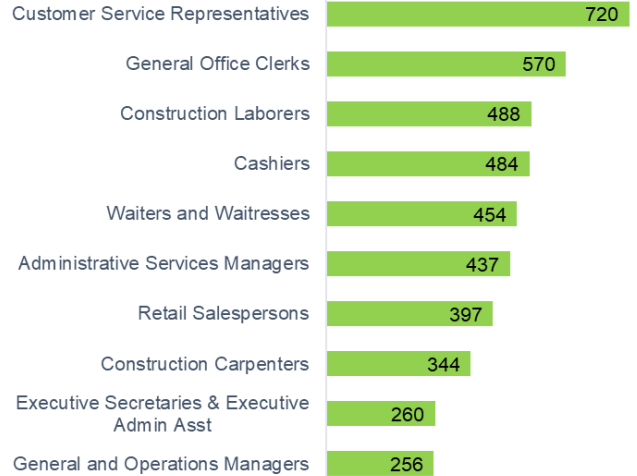


TOP 10 ADVERTISED JOB POSTINGS VS. CANDIDATES

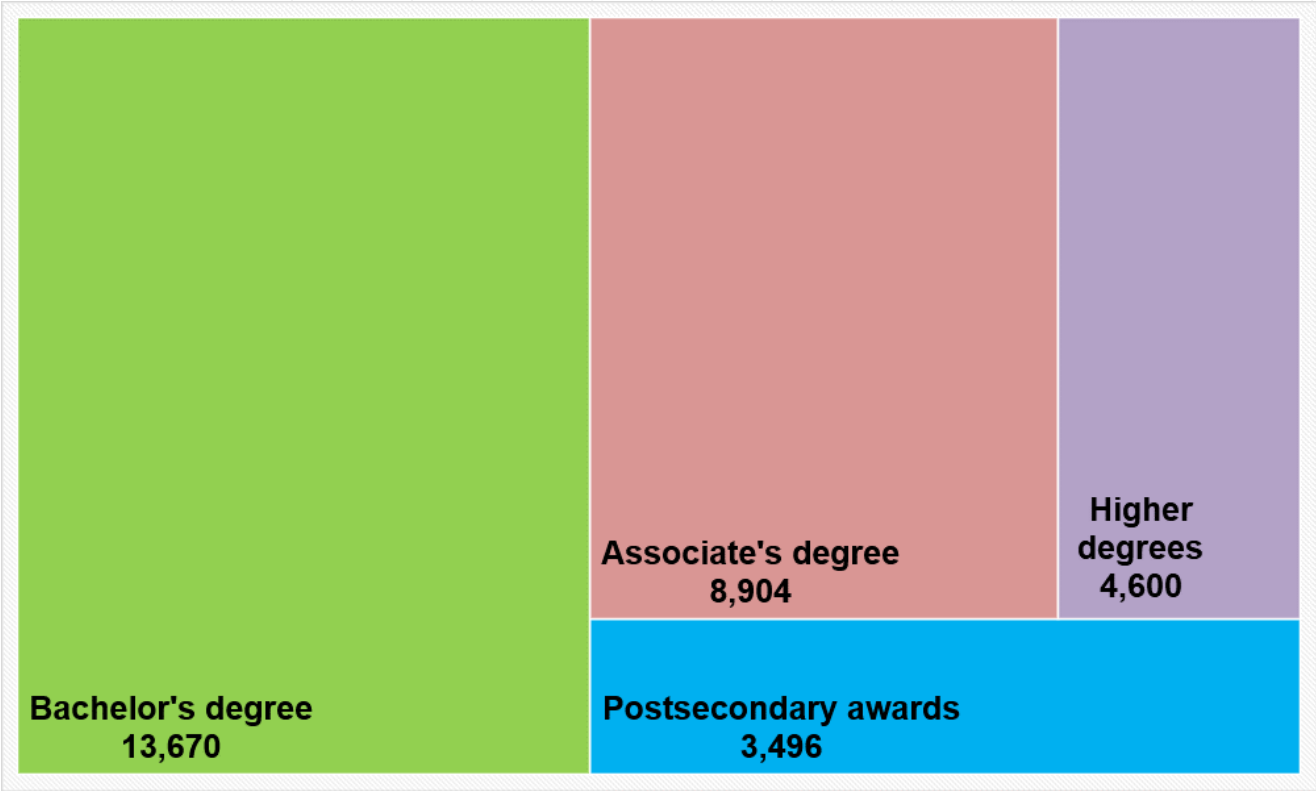
