



Outcomes

For High-Level Leaders

- Cultivate a cadre of advocates and champions for pathways work.
- Deepen leaders' knowledge and understanding of critical components in building a 6-16 (middle school through post-secondary) college and career pathways ecosystem.
- Identify strengths, opportunities, gaps, and challenges specific to Hawai'i to learn what is needed to scale a bold pathways vision. Use this learning to inform upcoming State plans.

For Implementers

- Comprehensive professional development offered to all practitioners statewide in core strategy areas to strengthen pathway implementation.
- Collaboration amongst HIDOE, University of Hawai'i, and key industry and community partners to come together as regional teams to strengthen and integrate student programs focused on promising career pathways.
