Alan Tang spoke at length with Jason Higa of FCH Enterprises (Zippy's) regarding a pilot program for the American Job Centers. As a way to make sure candidates are successful and stay on the job, candidates should receive some type of coaching and/or training from the application process. Alan Tang and Jason Higa have agreed to be a part of a task force to help oversee the pilot program. This process will give insight into both the employer and AJC perspective.

The final written report, which will include assessment findings from the surveys and interviews, tagline recommendations, brand users guide, and plan for brand rollout and outreach, will be submitted to WDC by March 29, 2019. The Employer Engagement Committee will review the final report and make a recommendation to the Executive Committee.
