Under WIOA, for a State to be eligible to receive allotments for the workforce development programs, the Governor shall submit a 4-year State plan with the "Required Elements" to the U.S. Secretary of Labor for the approval.

Under WIOA, local plans are due after the approval of the State plan by the U.S. Secretary of Labor.

# \*"§ 679.550 What are the requirements for the development of the local plan? (a) Under WIOA sec. 108, each Local WDB must, in partnership with the appropriate chief elected officials, develop and submit a comprehensive 4-year plan to the Governor.

(1) The plan must identify and describe the policies, procedures, and local activities that are carried out in the local area, consistent with the State Plan. ..."

\*Above is just a small portion of WIOA law that specifies local plan requirements. After WDC reviews and Governor approves Hawai'i's WIOA USP 2020-2023, it is available to local workforce development boards in each county, so they can move forward with their local plan development. After Hawai'i's WIOA USP is approved by the U.S. Secretary of Labor, each County develops and aligns it's WIOA 2020-2023 Local Plan with the State Plan and submits to WDC. WDC will provide local plan guidelines and deadlines to counties.
