# Department of Labor & Industrial Relations



Governor appointed Acting Director Anne Perreira-Eustaquio as Director and JoAnn Vidinhar as Deputy Director.

Labor/Tax building will be phasing in reopening by appointment-based public access and thermal temperature screening to enter through November 19.

Targeting opening building to the public on December 17 with temperature screenings.

## **GRANTS & FUNDED**



WDC partnered with UH: Awarded \$13.3M over 3 years to (1) increase short-term training leading to industry-valued credentials; (2) increase employment in in-demand living wage jobs; (3) expand high-quality apprenticeship opportunities; (4) develop post-apprenticeship career pathways and advancement opportunities. Only 8 states were awarded!

WDC partnered with UH Community Colleges: Workforce for Water proposal expands training to earn industry-recognized credentials statewide to replace 88,000 cesspools by 2050. Cesspools are at high risk for contaminating drinking water and coastal reefs. 4-year project for \$5M. Proposal submitted to USDOL on October 5. Pending award notification.

Almost \$2M returned WIOA funds from the counties, approved projects getting underway to issue Request for Proposals through procurement process, executing MOUs, contracts, to expend funds by June 30, 2021.
