

Waipahu Community School for Adults Report for WDC

- We are continuing to provide Adult Basic Education, Adult Secondary Education, English Language Acquisition, iCAN, Parapro and Sub-Teacher classes.
 - Classes are delivered through remote learning applications or in person to our most vulnerable population when needed. Approximately 90% of our students are attending classes remotely
- We are looking to resume special interest classes through a distance learning delivery where possible.
- We continue to work with our partners in providing an education program with their students that provides for the opportunity to receive a High School Equivalency (HSE) Diploma or Workforce Development Program (WDDP) Diploma. Some of our partners are Kinai Eha, Habilitat Hawaii, Job Corps Hawaii, Work Hawaii, Hawaii National Guard Youth Challenge, and the American Job Center Hawaii, to name a few
- The Windward Campus continue to provide classes to the Kaneohe Marine Corps Bases soldiers seeking promotion or advancement
- The Wahiawa Campus continue to provide classes to Schofield Barracks soldiers seeking promotion or advancement
- We had a few, free promotion events through some of our TV news and radio “friends” which brought in approximately 120 new registrants for our Fall Term 2.
- We continue to partner with UH Hilo and Chaminade University by allowing their counseling students to intern on our campuses on both Oahu and the Big Island
- Overall enrollment is still down relative to previous years even though we have been waiving our enrollment fees since Spring Term 2 through the present
