V. Executive Session – Discussion of a personnel matter regarding annual evaluation of the Executive Director under Hawaii Revised Statutes Chapter 92-5(a)(2)

Alan Hayashi motioned to enter into Executive Session to discuss personnel matters regarding collective bargaining salary adjustments of the Executive Director and other designated staff under Hawaii Revised Statues Chapter 92-5(a)(2). Jason Ito seconded the motion. There were no questions. The motion was adopted. The Executive Committee entered Executive Session at 4:23 p.m.

Alan Hayashi motioned to exit Executive Session. General Edward Richardson seconded the motion. There were no questions. The motion was adopted. The Executive Committee exited Executive Session at 4:40 p.m.

The public meeting reconvened at 4:41 p.m. Pursuant to Executive Order 20.09, collective bargaining will extend to exempt employees Executive Director Allicyn Tasaka and Jeanne Ohta, who will receive an increase in salary of 2.15% effective July 1, 2019 and 2.03% effective July 1, 2020.

Alan Hayashi motioned to have a letter sent to Human Resources pursuant to Executive Order 20.09. Shannon Okinaka seconded the motion. There were no comments, questions or abstentions. The motion was adopted unanimously.

VI. Reports and Possible Recommendations from Board Committees

The Finance Committee and the Employer Engagement Committee motioned for the approval of three funding proposals: \$54,969 to the Nursing Residency Program by Hawaii State Center for Nursing, \$30,000 to the Hawaii is Hiring 2.0 project by the Chamber of Commerce Hawaii, and \$60,000 to Employer Sector Partnerships. There were no questions, comments or abstentions. The motion was adopted unanimously.

The committee will continue to meet quarterly before board meetings: February, May, August and November 2021.

A poll will be sent to committee members to determine a meeting date before the next board meeting in February 2021.
