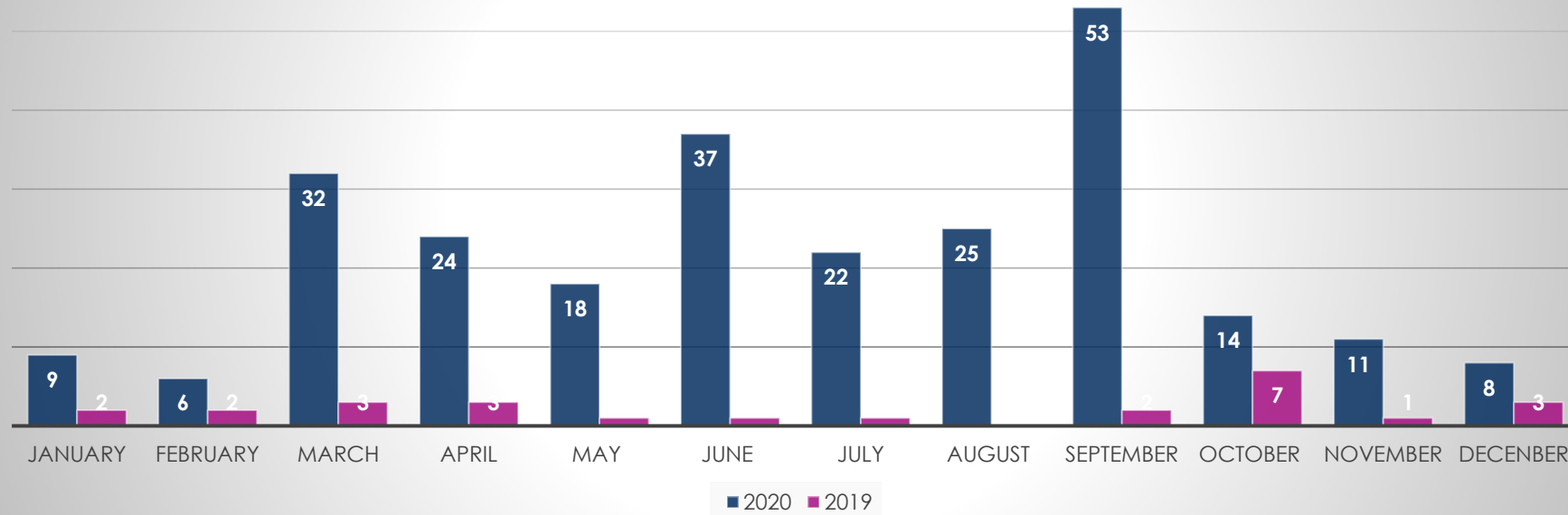

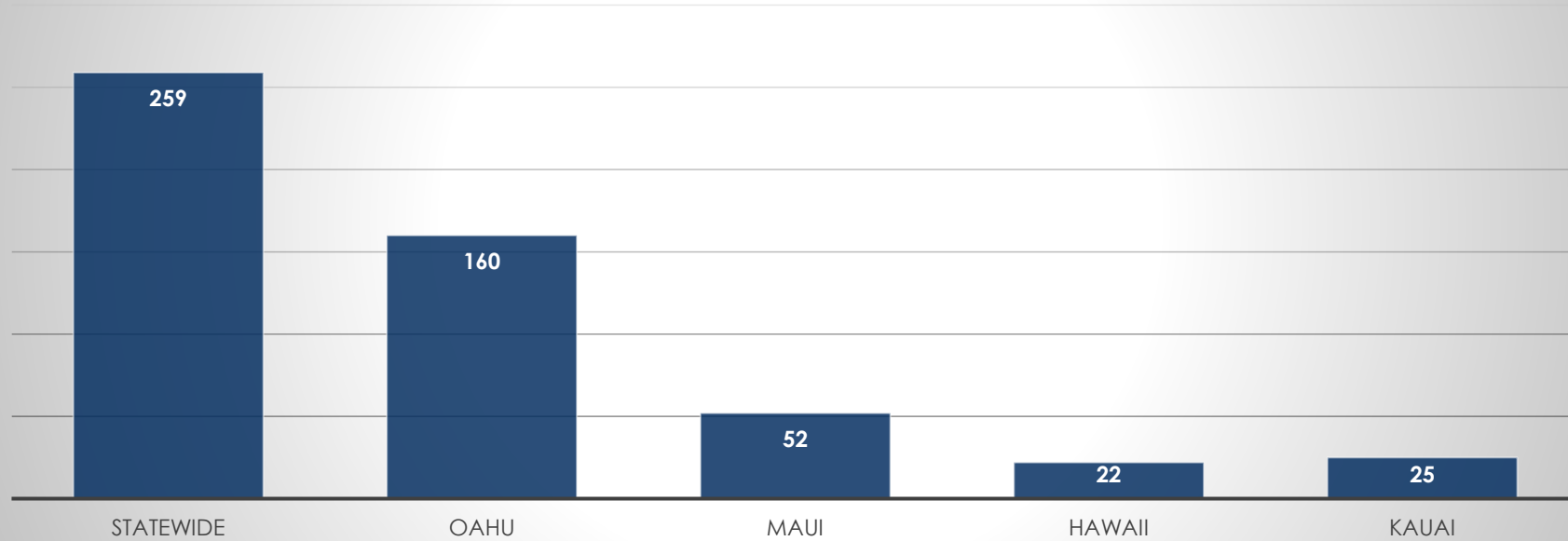


WARN notices 2020 vs 2019
