

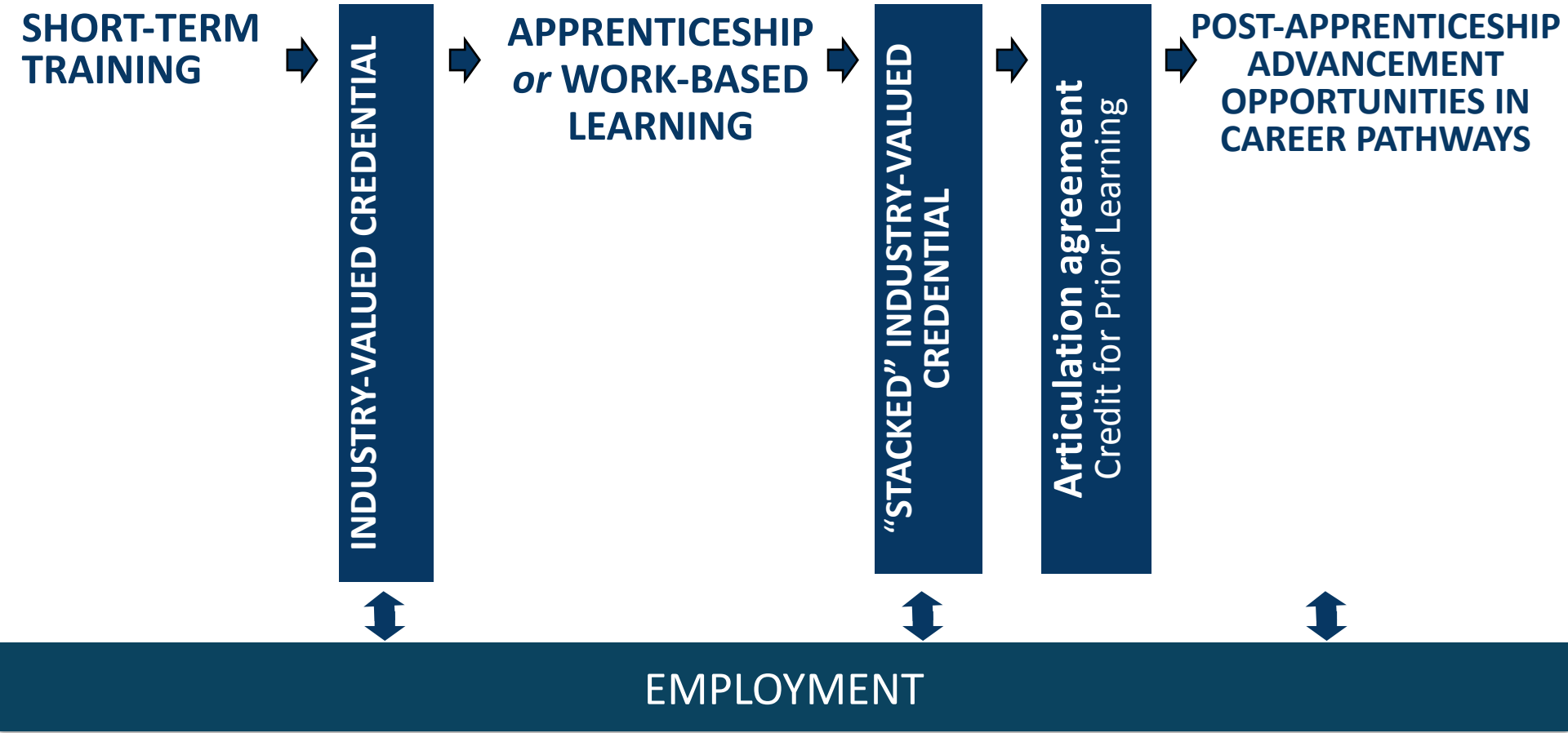

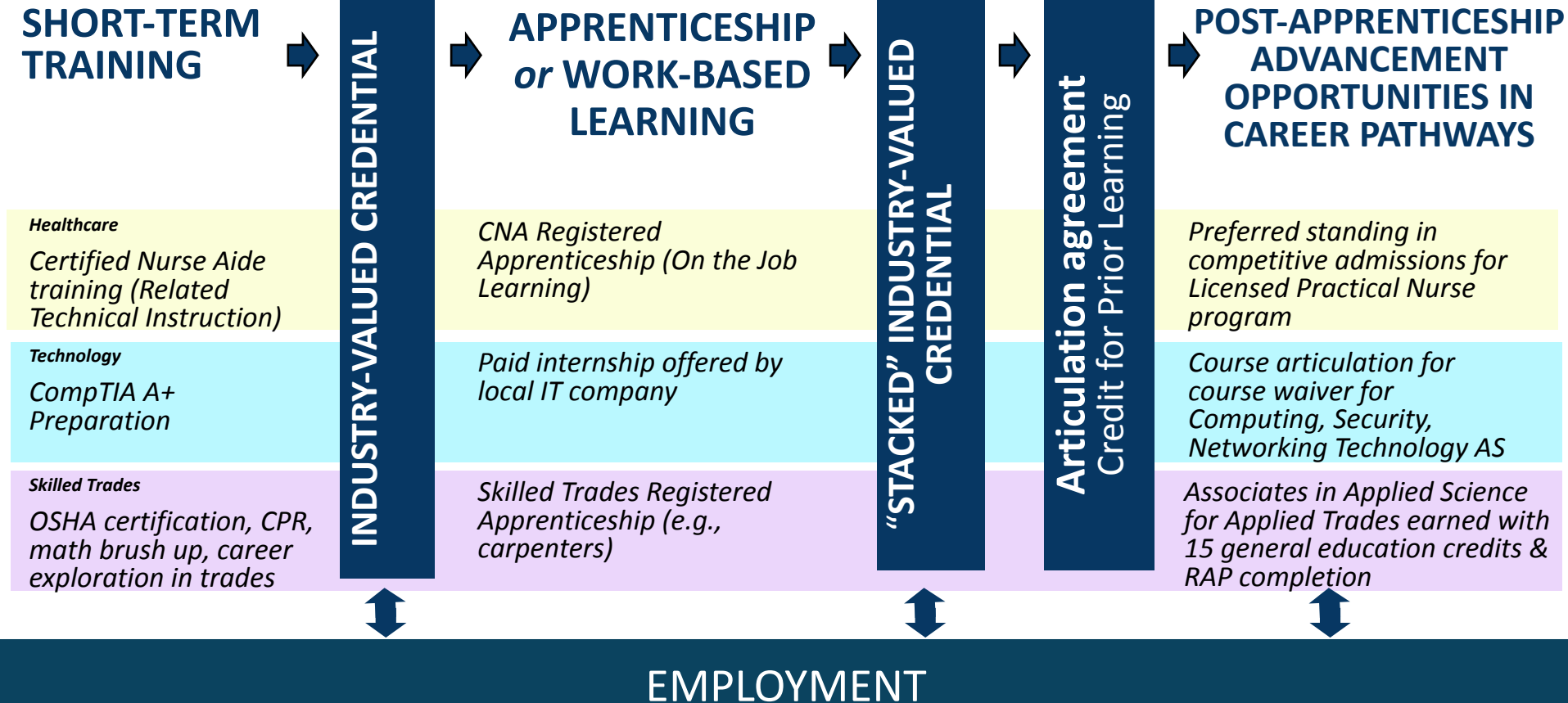

Participant Eligibility

- **Not currently working** (unemployed, furloughed, dislocated workers)
- **Underemployed** (working part/time and/or earning less than \$20/hour)
- **U.S. citizen or green card holder**

Demographics

- Underserved populations (Native Hawaiian, Pacific Islander)
- PROWRA (low income families, TANF, SNAP)
- Rural Opportunity Zones



Year 1 Targets (Oct 2020- Sept 2021)

- **Short term training:** 705 unemployed or underemployed (< \$20/hour)
- **Employed:** 449 with 292 in field of training (Median salary: \$38K)
- **Apprenticeship:** 176 registered apprentices



Industry Credentials in Resilient Sectors:

- **Healthcare:** Pharmacy Technician, Phlebotomy Technician, Certified Nurse Aide, Certified Dental Assistant, Patient Care Technician
- **Technology:** CompTIA A+, Security+, Network+, Amazon Web Services
- **Skilled Trades:** Agricultural Technician, CDL, Trades Pre-Apprenticeship, HVAC
