SUBJECT: HireNet Hawaii Rapid Response Event Codes

PURPOSE

The Workforce Development Council (WDC) and the Workforce Development Division (WDD) has issued this joint bulletin for the purpose of providing guidance for the attachment of Rapid Response Event Codes to all participants in HireNet Hawaii, who have attended a prior Rapid Response Event.

POLICY

During participant enrollment, if an individual has stated that they have attended a prior Rapid Response Event, attach the appropriate Rapid Response Event Code in HireNet Hawaii to the individual's application.

ACTION REQUIRED

To create a Rapid Response Event Code for each Rapid Response Event conducted, the Local Rapid Response Coordinator will work with the WDC Statewide Rapid Response Coordinator.

The following information below will need to be provided to the WDC Statewide Rapid Response Coordinator, in order for the Rapid Response Event Code to be created within the system:

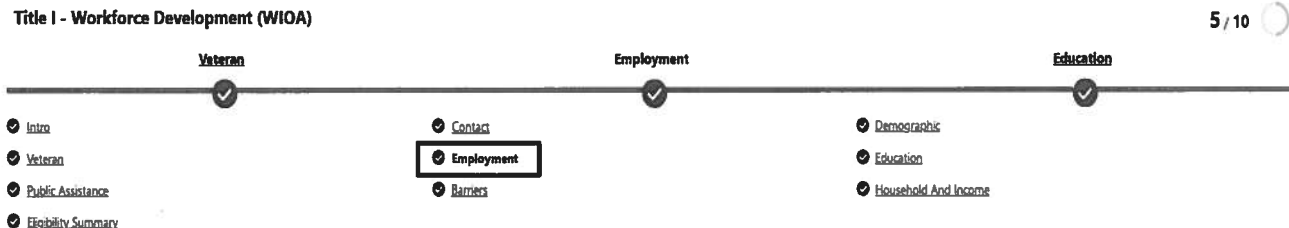
- **Company Name**
- **Company Main Address**
- **Rapid Response Event: Begin and End Date**
- **Event Type: WARN, Substantial Layoff or Other**
- **Event Classification: Closure, Layoff or N/A**
- **Number of Employees Affected**

The steps below outline how to attach the appropriate Rapid Response Event Code to an individual's application in HireNet Hawaii:

To attach the appropriate Rapid Response Event Code to an individual, go to the Employment tab in their WIOA application.



Under the Employment Information section, complete the three (3) Rapid Response questions.

- Attended a Rapid Response Orientation: **Select “Yes”**
- Most Recent Date Attended Rapid Response Service: **Enter the Date of Rapid Response Orientation attended**
- Rapid Response Event Number: **Click on “Find RR Event”**

Once you click on “Find RR Event,” a pop-up box will appear with various search filters to locate the appropriate Rapid Response Event Code for selection.

Quick tip: a quick way to bring up your County's Rapid Response Event list is to enter your island (i.e. Oahu, Hawaii, Maui & Kauai) under “Site Location” and search.



If the case manager is unable to locate the Rapid Response Event using the search box, an updated Rapid Response Event Codes list will be distributed to the American Job Centers statewide occasionally by the WDC Statewide Rapid Response Coordinator.
