Dear Scott Murakami,

On August 1, 2021, Flying Food Group, LLC and International In-Flight Catering ("Flying Food Group") issued notices pursuant to the Hawaii Dislocated Workers Act and Federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification (WARN) Acts. Those notices informed you that Flying Food Group expects to permanently lay off employees between October 1 and October 15, 2021.

We write to inform you that Flying Food Group's permanent layoffs have been postponed. Flying Food Group will conduct these permanent layoffs between **November 1, 2021 and November 14, 2021**.

Flying Food Group is postponing the permanent layoffs due to the fact that the Company will not exhaust federal funds provided under the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security Act (the "CARES Act") and subsequent amendments until after November 1, 2021.
