Re: Notice of Temporary Suspension of Operations at Arancino Beachwalk

To Whom It May Concern,

Please accept this letter as notification that Arancino Beachwalk, 255 Beachwalk Avenue, temporarily halted its operations on March 31, 2020, due to the unforeseen business circumstances caused by the natural disaster and spread of COVID 19, the Governor of Hawaii's declaration of emergency, as well as the recently issued recommendations and/or orders regarding public gatherings by the CDC and various other government agencies and officials.

It is anticipated that this cessation of operations of the business will be temporary; however, based on the fluid and rapidly evolving nature of this situation, we are unable to provide a specific date at which we will be able to recommence operations at this time.

We have temporarily ceased partial operations of the location; thus, there are no bumping rights.

As a result of the temporary cease in operations on March 31, 2020, approximately 43 individuals (including part-time employees) who are employed at Arancino di Mare and 37 individuals will be put into layoff status. A list of the job titles of the employees who will be affected, and the number of employees with each job title, is attached. None of the employees are represented by a union.
