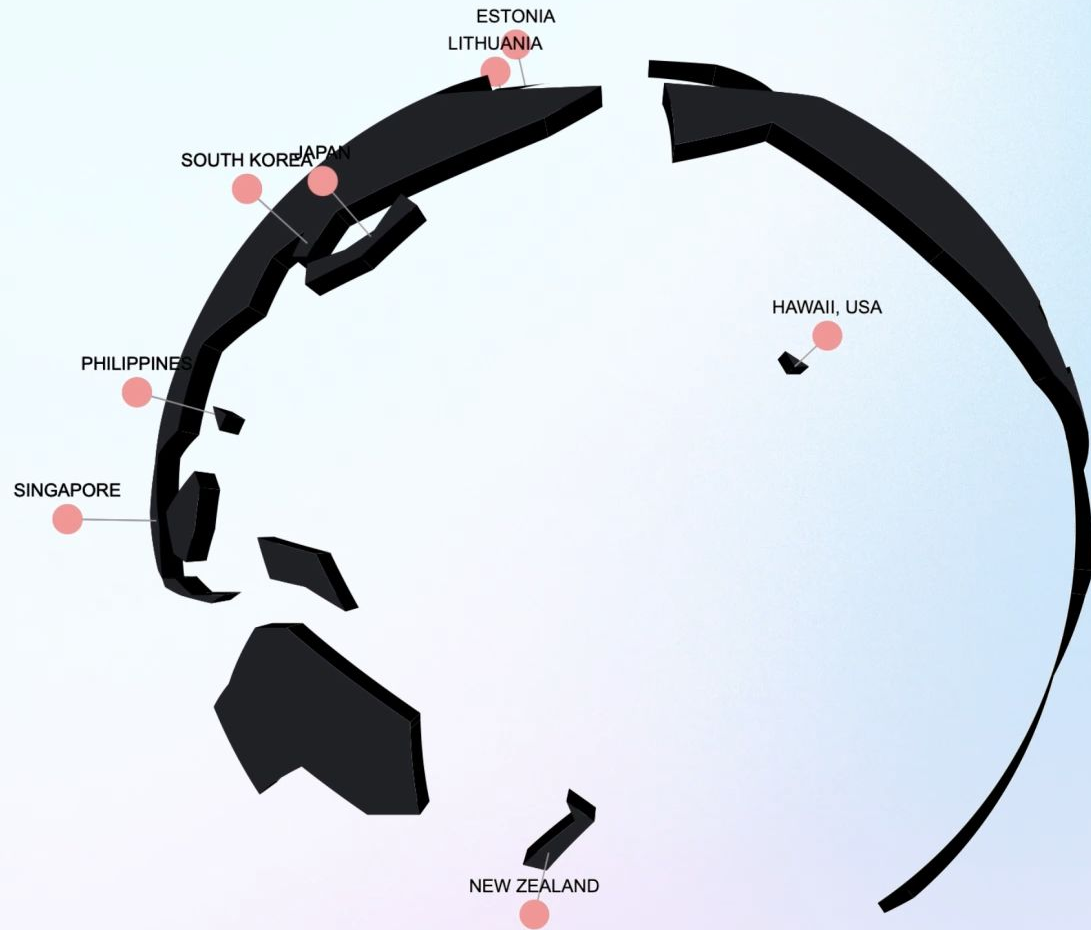

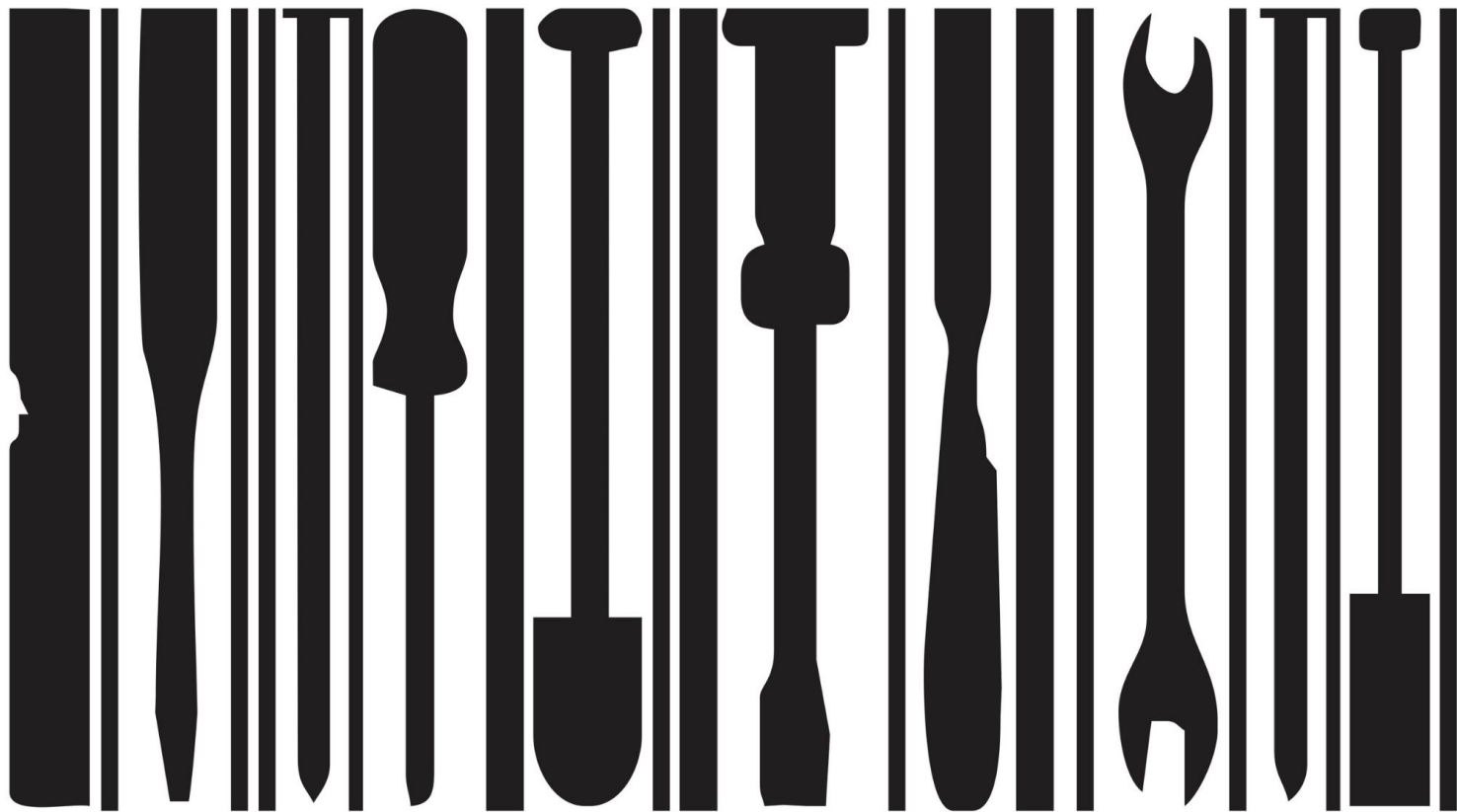
Tour the space and learn more about VIVITA and set expectations for kids + parents

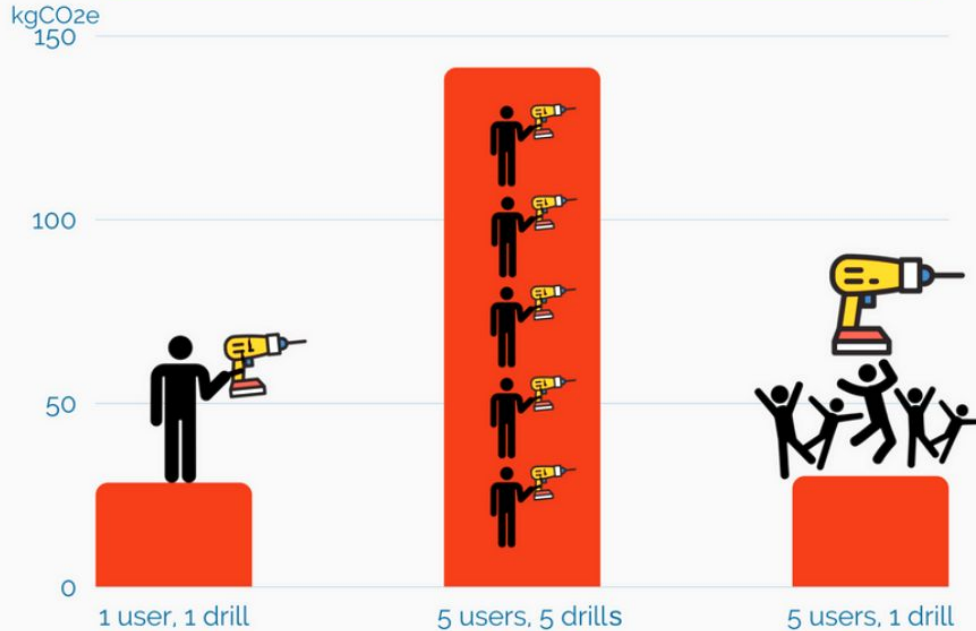

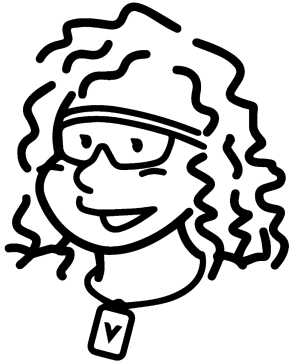

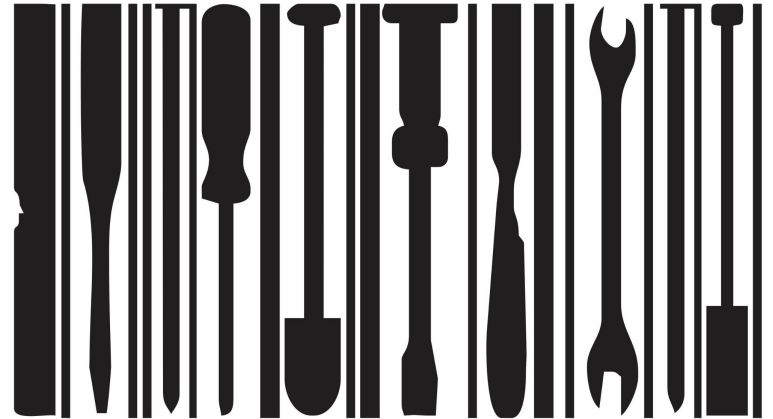
