## The Employer Engagement Committee met on Thursday, April 13, 2023.

Rick Nakashima the owner of Ruby Tuesday Hawaii, Gyu-Kaku Hawaii, and Rainbow Drive-In Kalihi spoke at the meeting about the post-COVID impacts on staffing in the restaurant industry. An emphasized point was the housing issues that Hawaii is facing and the dire need to address it.
