The projects' goal is to increase healthcare education capacity and to expand support of nursing clinical placements across the state and allied health. Currently, they are asking for full funding for Phase 1 which includes expanding to Maui and establish allied health HCPC Workgroup on Maui and Oahu starting January 1, 2023, through June 30, 2023. Also, in the proposed budget is 2 full time employees for 6 months and 10 CCPS/Software Licenses Fees.

Chair Miyashiro entertained a motion for the approval of Phase 1 and to move the proposal from Committee to the Executive Session for further discussion. Jean Schneider moved to accept. Keala Peters seconded the motion. There were no objections or abstentions. The motion was approved unanimously.
