Digital Work Skills (Community Project Funding)

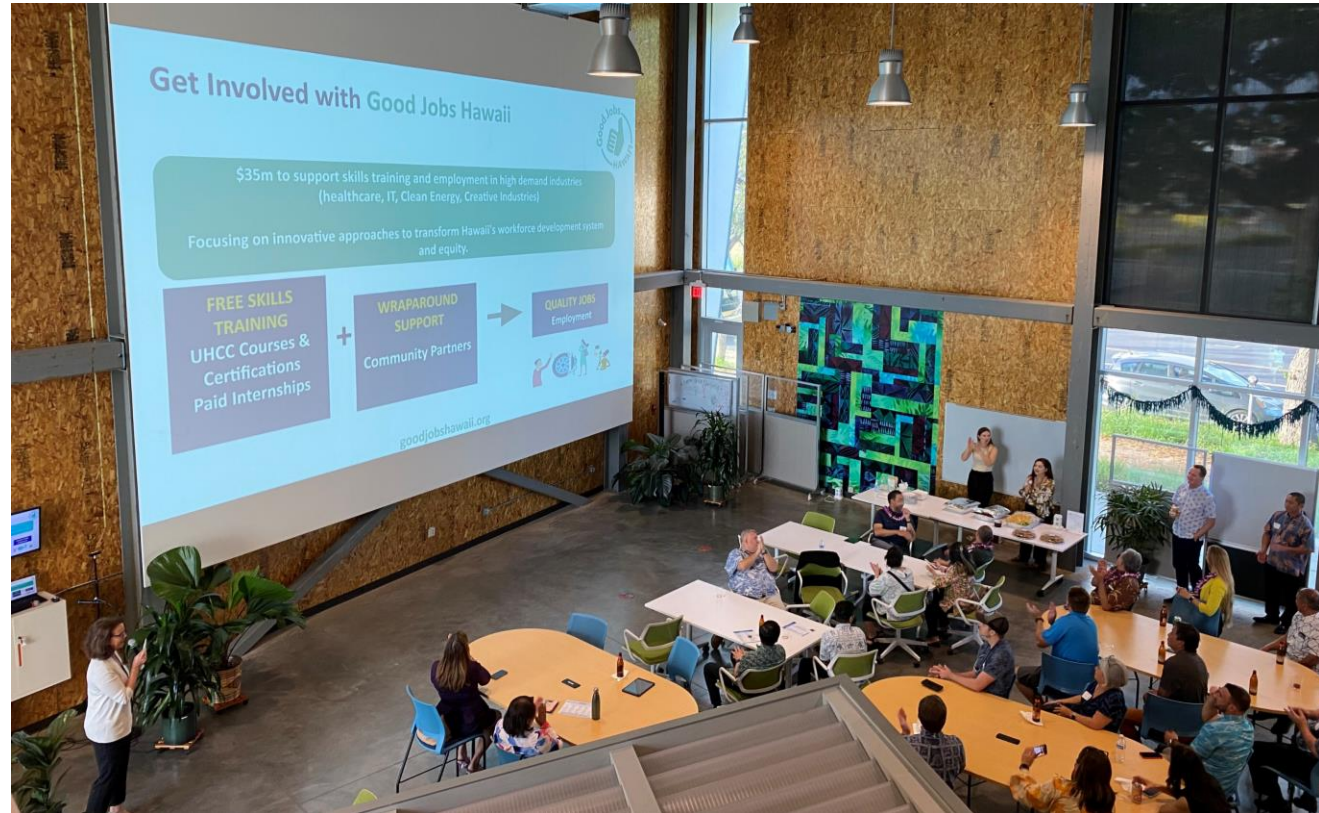
- \$975,000 awarded to Hawaii DLIR
- Grant provides for Digital Work Skills classes to be delivered statewide
- 2-year grant
- Anticipating to serve minimum of 400 participants
- Partners for this project include Dept. of Education Community School for Adults, Hawaii State Public Libraries and Dept. of Business, Economic Development & Tourism.
- Contracts/MOUs currently being developed with expected execution date of August 1, 2023
