<b>OPENING AND CLOSING:</b>	Applications will be accepted from Monday, June 25, 2018, 7:30 AM until Tuesday, July 31, 2018, 4:00 PM.
<b>NUMBER OF APPLICANTS:</b>	The recruitment shall close upon receipt of the first three hundred (300) <b>completed</b> applications or on the designated closing date and time. Whichever comes first.
<b>APPLICATION DEADLINE:</b>	Applications must be completed by: Tuesday, July 31, 2018, 4:00 PM
<b>RESUME:</b>	A resume <b>must</b> be submitted with your application. (Upload as a .pdf or .doc file)
<b>GEOGRAPHICAL AREA:</b>	All applicants must reside within the geographical area covered by IUEC Local 126, which encompasses the islands of Hawai‘i, Kaua‘i, Lāna‘i, Maui, Moloka‘i, O‘ahu, and Ni‘ihau.

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

<b>AGE:</b>	Applicants must be at least eighteen (18) years of age on or before Tuesday, July 31, 2018.
<b>EDUCATION:</b>	Applicants shall be a high school graduate or provide proof of equivalent educational attainment such as completion of the General Education Development (GED) tests. Each applicant shall submit (upload), with the completed application, a high school transcript, or high school diploma, or an official report of GED test results. College transcripts will not be accepted in lieu of a high school diploma or a GED.
<b>APTITUDE:</b>	All applicants shall pass an examination designed to test the applicant’s reading, math skills, and aptitude for employment in the elevator industry.
<b>PHYSICAL:</b>	Applicants must be capable of performing the physical requirements of the job without posing a threat to the health and safety of themselves or others.
<b>OTHER:</b>	Upon selection, the applicant must pass a drug test. (Paid for by the employer) <u>A government issued photo I.D.</u> must be presented during the application process.
