DOMESTIC WORKERS
HAVE RIGHTS

If you work in a home, cleaning, cooking, caring for a child, doing laundry, or other domestic service, you have the right to:

- + Be free from discrimination on the job
- + Payment of at least the state minimum wage
- + Overtime pay after 40 hours of work in a week
