THEATRICAL EMPLOYMENT SCHOOL CERTIFICATION

(To be Used for Minors Under 14 Only)

Under Section 12-25-22(3), Hawaii Administrative Rules, minors under fourteen years of age may be employed or permitted to work in theatrical employment provided that the employer submits to the DLIR, whenever employment would occur during a school year, a statement signed by an authorized school official indicating that the attendance at school and the school work of the minor are satisfactory.
